

Reporting procedures for border violations

at the KHG Karlsruhe

Do you need help because you have been subjected to physical, psychological, verbal, spiritual or other forms of violence? Have you been told about such incidents or have you witnessed them?

Internal support

At most KHG **events**, you can receive **immediate help**. You'll find **members of the parish team** here. In exceptional cases, other volunteers may be in charge of the event. They too have been briefed on the procedures set out in the safety policy.

- The **full-time contact persons** can also be found outside of events in the **offices of the KHG building**. They can also be reached **by telephone** (see link above). They can provide you with a confidential space to talk.
- **In the halls of residence**, the **floor representatives** are the first points of contact.
